In a bid to promote and preserve the heritage, Intach's Heritage Education and Communication Services held a film making workshop at Sunbeam English School Bhagwanpur wherein 17 schools of Varanasi participated. The workshop was intended to encourage the youth of the nation to use technology as a powerful medium to educate people about the country's heritage and need to preserve it for future generations.

This workshop started with a short movie on HECS which is a branch of INTACH and works to nurture cultural understanding, care and concern towards our heritage. Audiences present there were shown two videos to help them gain a fair amount of knowledge on how to make an impact with a simple yet strong subject.

Mr. Anshul shared some pre-requisites of movie making with the children; topics from the development of idea, planning of shooting/video making, taking of videos and pictures from different angles, how to record the sound in a movie, making of checklists and last and most important editing was taken up and discussed in detail. He also explained about the precautions one must take while shooting, importing or exporting a file and further showed them how a sample editing is done to make them understand how a sample video is converted into a professional video.

Mr. Abhishek - an INTACH official, later educated students on how to streamline abstract ideas and create a short movie on it. The importance of a positive and humorous ending in a movie was also discussed by the students. The session was very interactive and successfully motivated students to use their creative skills and inspired them to come up with different ideas/topics. This was then followed by informing the students about the topics they can select for this year short film making workshop.

It was an enriching experience for our students to learn the art of movie-making from the industry experts and feel responsible for safeguarding the heritage of our country and making necessary efforts in the same regards.
