5. "Back to School, Ready to Grow!"



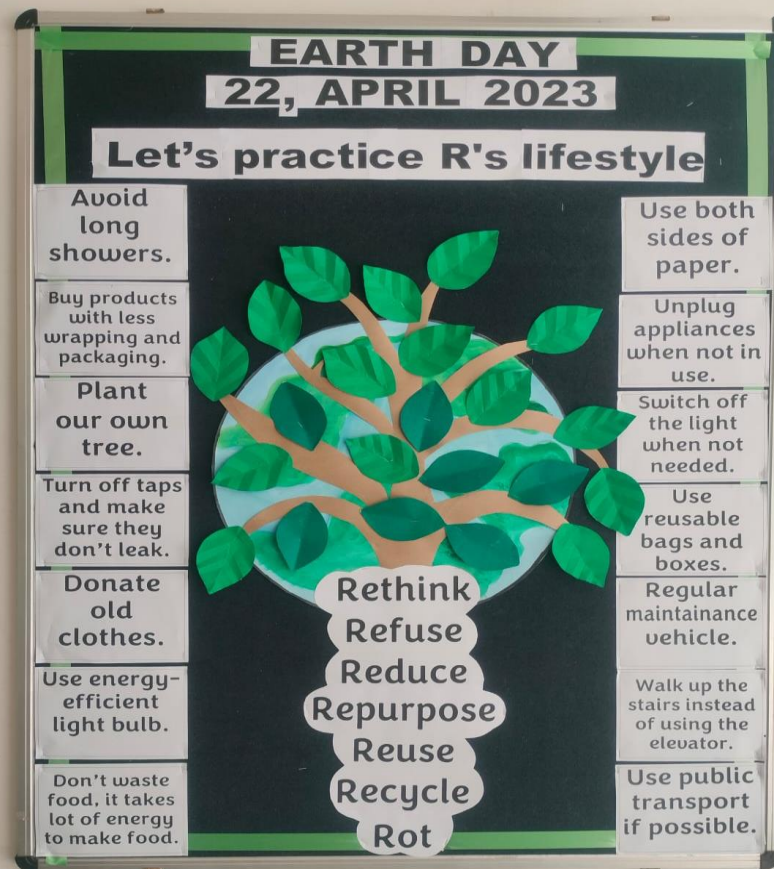

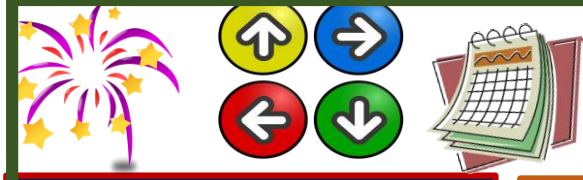


# Voices Of Future

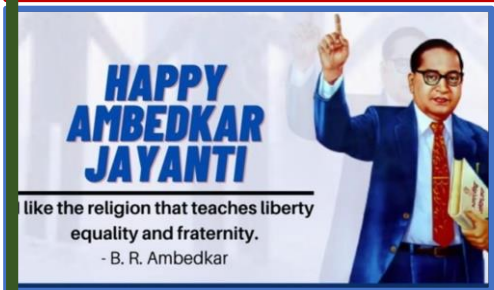




# Dates to Remember
