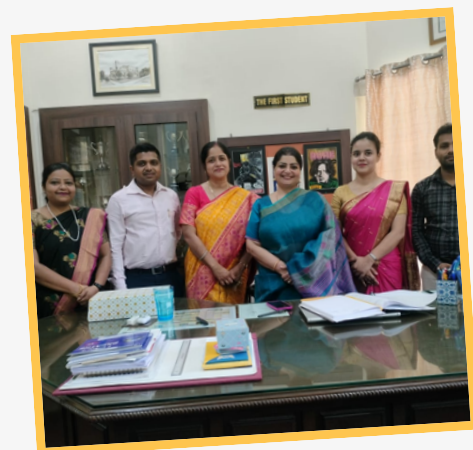
Fenestra 7.0

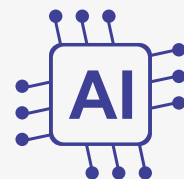

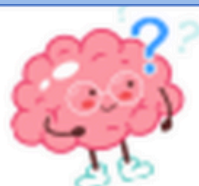
